Strictly between 1.00 pm – 3.00 pm Tuesday 3 and Wednesday 4 November

### OPENING NIGHT AND AWARD CEREMONY

5.30 pm Friday 6 November 2020 at the Darwin Supreme Court

### EXHIBITION DATES

Artwork will be displayed at the Darwin Supreme Court:  
Friday 6 November - Friday 20 November 2020  
Opening hours are 8:00 am - 4.00 pm, Monday – Friday (week days only)

### ARTWORK COLLECTION

Artworks are to be collected from the Darwin Supreme Court on Tuesday 24 and Wednesday 25 November, between 8.00am - 4.00 pm only.

*Any uncollected artwork will be disposed of.*

### GENERAL ENTRY CONDITIONS

- All entries must be the original work of the artist
- Please complete a separate entry form for each piece entered by the same artist
- Artwork should be ready to hang with string, wire, eyelets etc. Unframed works on paper will be pinned if possible
- Consent is given to DCLS reproducing exhibited work/s for promotional purposes, in all media, at no charge (eg. in their Annual Report or on their Facebook page).
- Delivery of artwork and collection of the artwork is the responsibility of the artist. DCLS will not incur any costs
- Artworks larger than 2x2 metres (2D) or 2x1x1 metres (3D) must be pre-approved by the Rights on Show Coordinator. All large 2D, all 3D, electronic multi-media and performance works must be discussed with the Rights on Show Coordinator to ensure the exhibition venue will accommodate the work and maximise quality of display
- All sales are to be managed by the artist – DCLS takes no commission and will not be involved in sales
- DCLS staff and Board members may submit artwork, but are not eligible for prizes or sale of their artwork
- DCLS volunteers may enter without restriction
- A maximum of 5 pieces may be submitted per person (this may change in future)
- DCLS reserves the right to refuse entries
