1. Website Visitors

- DCLS collects non-personally-identifying information such as:
 - Browser type;
 - Language preference;
 - Referring site;
 - The behaviour of visitors on the website; and
 - The date and time of each visitor request.
- This information is collected to better understand how DCLS’s visitors use this website, and may be released in its entirety, e.g. in the form of a published report on the trends of usage of the website.
- Potentially personally-identifying information may be collected, such as Internet Protocol (IP) addresses, to be used, disclosed and stored as provided in the DCLS Privacy of Personal Information Policy.

2. Third Party Links

- The DCLS website may contain links to other websites provided by third parties not under DCLS’s control.
- When following a link and providing information to a 3rd-party website, please be aware that DCLS is not responsible for the data provided to that third party.

3. Cookies

- Information about how the DCLS website is used is collected automatically using “cookies”. This information is used to track visitor use of the website and to compile statistical reports on website activity.
 - The following types of cookies may be collected:
 - Performance: information on how users interact with websites hosted on the DCLS website, including what pages are visited most, as well as other analytical data. These details are only used to improve how the website functions.

- Tracking: These are set by trusted third party networks (e.g. Google Analytics) to track details such as the number of unique visitors, and pageviews to help improve the user experience.
- Third Party/Embedded Content: DCLS makes use of different third party applications and services to enhance the experience of website visitors. These include social media platforms such as Facebook and Twitter (through the use of sharing buttons), or embedded content from YouTube and Vimeo. As a result, cookies may be set by these third parties, and used by them to track your online activity. DCLS has no direct control over the information that is collected by these cookies.
